Why we need this program?

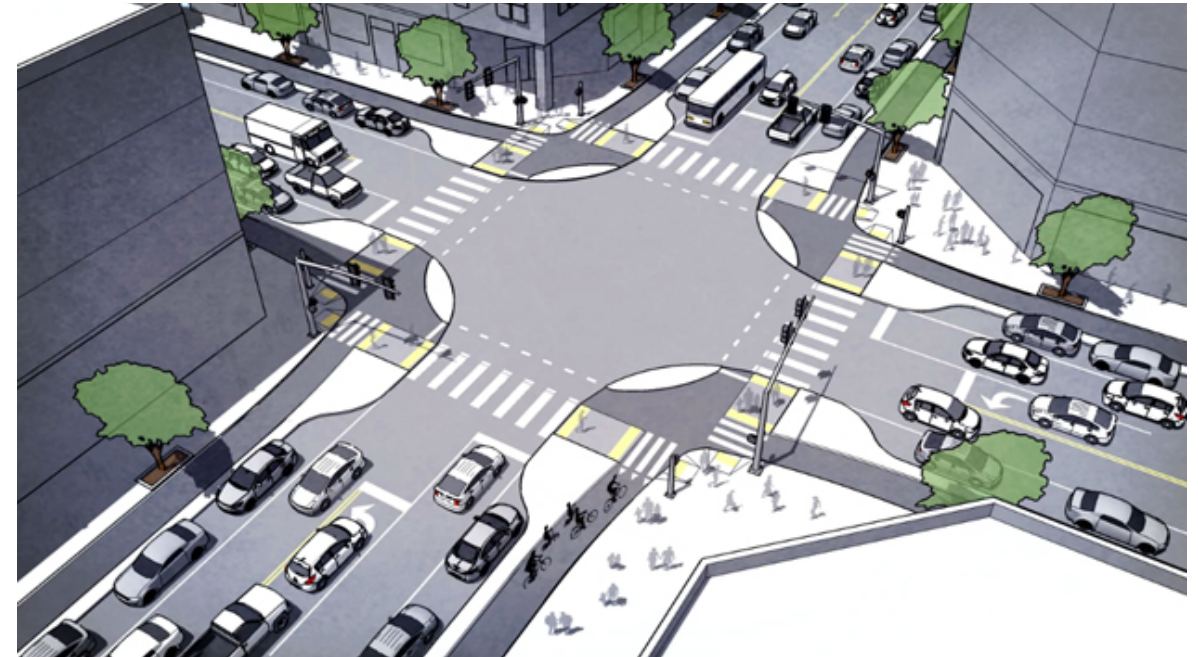
- Increase social interaction

- 1- Signal
- 2- Crosswalk
- 3- Pedestrian curb cut Ramp locations
- 4- Sign
- 5- Bulb-outs



What we can do?

Sidewalk features:

- 1- Striping
- 2- transit Lane
- 3- Bike Path
- 4- Median
- 5- On-Street Parking



What we can do?

Corridor features:

- 1- Lighting
- 2- Seating Area
- 3- Bus Stop
- 4- Wayfinding
- 5- Bike Rack
- 6- Landscaping



How you can help:

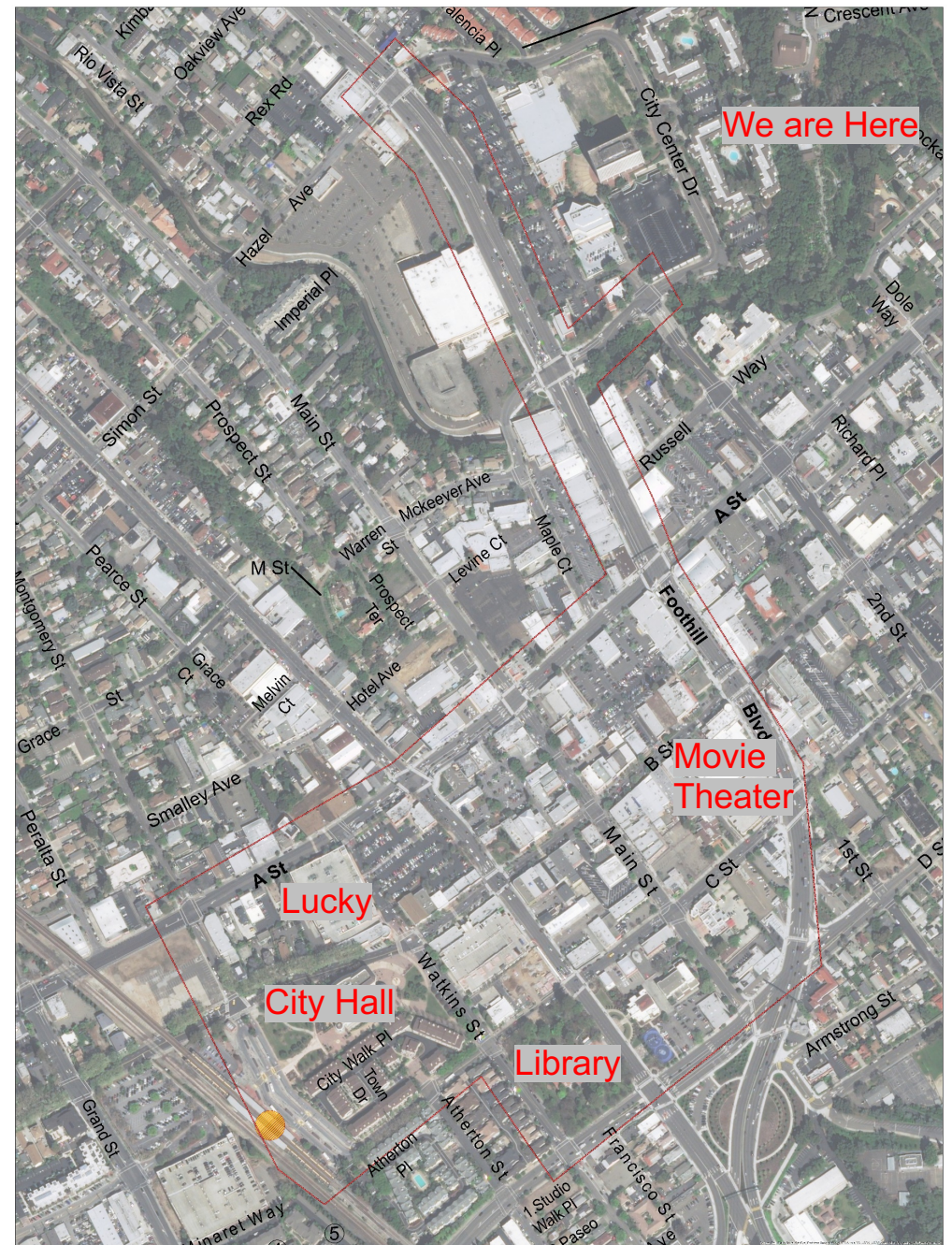
You can help to make your community more walkable by identifying the roads and intersections that are challenging for pedestrians to walk and cross.
