
CORE OBJECTIVE

Develop intersection redesign concepts in downtown Hayward to increase pedestrian safety, especially for senior pedestrians, as a means of encouraging senior citizens to walk more.





SAFETY BENEFITS OF SPEED REDUCTION



As speeds increase, drivers are less aware of their surroundings



TRADEOFFS

Ped safety

- Reduce injuries
- Reduce severity
- Greater comfort

Driver Convenience

- Reduce speeds
- Increase delay
- Increase travel times








Left-turning vehicle conflicts


- Very long crossing distances (>110 ft)








GEOMETRIC CHANGES AND STRIPING

- Reduce Excess Pavement
- Eliminate Low Volume Right-Turn Lanes
- Simplify Intersection Geometry
- Perpendicular Crosswalks
- Increase Visibility of Pedestrians
- Vehicle Speed Reduction
