SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

ROBBERY: On 01/07/2024 at 9:39 PM, four subjects walked into the victim business near the 1000 block of Industrial Pkwy W. The subjects used force and took property from the business. The suspects fled the scene in a vehicle. (Report #: 2024-001386)

ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON: On 01/11/2024 at 12:36 PM, officers responded to the report of an assault with a deadly weapon near the 24000 block of Santa Clara St. Officers located the suspect, who had struck the victim with a blunt object, and he was taken into custody.
