## Officials Laud Selection in Hayward Area

SACRAMENTO, Dec. 16 — Selection of the Hauschildt property for the Alameda County State College brought full approval from Hayward and college officials here yesterday.

"We are very happy that the Public Works Board has selected a site for the college," said Commissioner John Poulos. "Hayward will cooperate with the state in bringing the college to its development as soon as possible."

"We're very pleased with the selection of the Hauschildt site," echoed Jack Ross, chairman of the Hayward State College Commission. "This was the site which we first proposed for selection."

Dr. Fred Hueston, president of the college, said, "The
