RESOLUTION BY THE HAYWARD CITY COUNCIL SALUTING CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, HAYWARD, ON ITS SILVER ANNIVERSARY.

WHEREAS, the California State University, Hayward, is one of the major employers in the county with over 1,400 employees representing a current payroll of nearly \$30 million; and

WHEREAS, working budgets accumulated over the past quarter century indicate a budget approaching half a billion dollars; and

WHEREAS, present enrollment of 12,600 ranks in the top ten percent of all public universities in the country. Cal State is 147th largest of 1,874 public four-year colleges; and

WHEREAS, nearly 150,000 persons have matriculated since classes began in 1959. Continuing education students have accounted for another 30,000; and

WHEREAS, thirty thousand men and women throughout the nation call CSUH their alma mater, with some 25,000 students having received their bachelor's degree and 5,000 their master's; and

WHEREAS, ethnic minority enrollment accounts for over 35 percent of the student body, reflecting the rich cultural diversity of the city and community the University serves; and

WHEREAS, more than half a million members of the community have attended sports and cultural events including drama productions, concerts, recitals, art shows, museum exhibitions, lectures and special educational activities such as the annual Science Festival; and

WHEREAS, the University has maintained a national reputation for high academic standards, a distinguished and notable faculty, and a highly dedicated and professional staff; and

WHEREAS, the University is celebrating the Twenty-fifth Anniversary of its founding in 1957 with a year-long schedule of special educational and cultural events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward does hereby salute California State University, Hayward, on its Silver Anniversary and in so doing encourages all citizens to participate in the numerous events and congratulates President Ellis E. McCune and all faculty, staff and students on this memorable occasion.
