VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

PET PAL VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day, Monday - Sunday

I would like to volunteer for this activity

These volunteers provide companionship and exercise to adoptable animals. As a Pet Pal Volunteer, you will be giving animals a better chance for adoption while making their stay at the shelter a happier and less lonely one.

GROOMING VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day, Monday - Sunday

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Grooming Volunteers provide tender loving care to the animals by bathing, brushing and grooming them. This can simply result in making an animal more comfortable, or help them look their best when they go up for adoption.

KENNEL VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day, Monday - Sunday

I would like to volunteer for this activity

As a Kennel Volunteer you make an immediate and important difference in the lives of the animals in our shelter. You will provide them with clean cages, fresh water and food, and lots of love and care. You can also help by doing laundry, washing dishes, and cleaning litter pans.

SPECIAL RESOURCE VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day, Monday - Sunday

Special talents or skills are put to use here. If you are a photographer, computer expert or artist willing to publicize your skills, you can fit right in.

ADOPTION COUNSELING VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any afternoon, Tuesday - Saturday

As an Adoption Volunteer you will counsel and screen potential adopters and match adoptable animals with loving homes. This rewarding job requires a training course that covers shelter policies, animal behavior and other related topics. This position is ideal for those who have compassion for both people and animals.

FOSTER CARE VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Foster care volunteers provide temporary housing in their own homes for young or sick animals.

TRANSPORTATION VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Upon demand

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Offsite events that involve our shelter animals need special volunteers that can provide transportation to/from the event location. If you are of legal driving age and have a clean record, this may be the position for you.

CLERICAL VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day, Tuesday - Saturday

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Clerical volunteers provide support in a myriad of ways; mailing out educational materials to schools, filing, photocopying, addressing invitations or stuffing envelopes. There are many ways to help out at the shelter.

LOST AND FOUND VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Any day

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Lost and Found Volunteers help reunite lost animals with their guardians. Duties include reviewing the Lost and Found Board and Books and checking the Kennel for these lost pets; phoning the owners of lost pets periodically to find out if they have found their pet; keeping the Lost and Found Book organized and up-to-date.

HUMANE EDUCATOR VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Varies

I would like to volunteer for this activity

Attitudes can be fostered and changed through education, but we need you to help us get the word out! Humane Education Volunteers present educational programs and workshops to children in both public and private schools within the City of Hayward. These programs are designed to teach compassion, respect and responsibility for all animals.

SPECIAL EVENTS VOLUNTEER

Days needed: Varies

Special Events Volunteers assist at fund-raisers and community outreach events. Tasks may include: working an informational booth, selling items, showcasing animals, or assisting with the transportation and set up of equipment and supplies required for the event.
