

SEWER SERVICE CHARGES
(Effective October 1, 2007)

Sewer service charges cover the cost of providing sewage collection and treatment services, including maintenance and replacement of worn equipment and sewer lines.

SEWER CONNECTION FEES

Sewer connection charges are fees paid by those wishing to connect a new facility to the public sewer system or to increase the volume and/or waste strength of wastewater from an existing facility. The funds are used to pay for system improvements needed to accommodate new growth and future development.
