Applicants applying for all commissions above must reside within the Hayward city limits and be a registered voter. Applicants for the Downtown Business Improvement Area Advisory Board need not live in Hayward; however, must own a business in the Downtown Business Improvement Area of Hayward and pay assessments. Applicants for the Economic Development Committee could either be a resident of Hayward or do business in the City of Hayward. Please be aware that there is a requirement for some of the commissions/committees/task force above to file a Statement of Economic Interests, Form 700.
