The City of Hayward is hosting the 42nd Annual Earth Day Poster and Writing Contest as part of Hayward's celebration of Earth Day. All Hayward students are invited to submit a poster, poem, or essay inspired by the environment. Entries may focus on one or more of the following topics:



Entries will be judged based on originality, clarity, and expression of theme. There will be four winners for each grade category (two winners for poster entries and two winners for poem/essay entries).

The grade categories are:

K-1st Grade

2nd-3rd Grade

4th-5th Grade

6th-8th Grade

9th-12th Grade

Rules

1. All posters, poems, and essays must be the sole work of the entrant
2. Poems and essays must be typed or neatly handwritten and one page maximum
3. Posters must be no larger than 12" x 18". Posters can be created digitally or traditionally
