



Completion of Quick-Build Solutions

Quick-Build Solutions	Status
Installed 25mph speed limit signs before major curves	Complete
Installed raised flexible posts along centerline	Complete
Trimmed tree branches to improve visibility	Complete
Installed advance pedestrian crossing signs	Complete
Painted high-visibility crosswalk markings and yield lines	Complete
Installed No Truck signs at the two ends of the corridor	Complete
Installed Class IV protected bike lanes with bollards	Complete
Painted green bike lane conflict dashed markings	Complete
Added 300' of on-street parking north of Oakes Dr	Complete






Pilot Program for Lane Reduction

- Initiated the pilot program for lane reduction in February 2023
- Temporary closed off second southbound lane with flexible posts
- Monitored traffic and emergency response times






Feedback From Community

Support from Community	Concerns from Community
 Safer access to and from residential driveways 	 Frustrating to be behind slow drivers or buses
 Slowed down speeding vehicles 	Flexible posts made the lanes too narrow
 Hayward Police Department supports the lane reduction 	Flexible posts get easily damaged
 Fire Department and AC Transit buses have no issues

Speed Reduction Results

- 17% reduction in speed north of Oakes Drive
- 11% reduction in speed south of Oakes Drive
- Less than 4% of all vehicles were driving below 25mph in April 2023
- Less than 1% of all vehicles were buses and heavy trucks






