The event includes a variety of engaging activities including start-up pitches, a fireside chat focusing on the latest technology trends, start-up company exhibitions, and a start-up job carnival. The keynote panel will feature Cal State East Bay President Cathy Sandeen, Dean of College of Business and Economics Gangaram Singh and City of Hayward Mayor Mark Salinas.

This inaugural event will mark the biggest start-up tech event in Hayward. It is expected to attract a mix of innovative companies, investors, venture capitalists, and start-ups, presenting opportunities for collaboration, investment, and professional development.
