A charter amendment to move city general elections from June to November

A **yes** vote is a vote in favor of moving the city's general election from June in even-numbered years to November in even-numbered years to coincide with state and federal general elections.

A **no** vote is a vote against moving the city's general election to November and in favor of continuing to hold Hayward general elections in June of even-numbered years.

A utility tax renewal

A **yes** vote is a vote in favor of authorizing the city to renew for 20 year's its utility users tax of 5.5 percent on gas, electricity, television and telephone services.

A **no** vote is a vote against renewing the city's utility tax, allowing the tax to expire in June 2019
