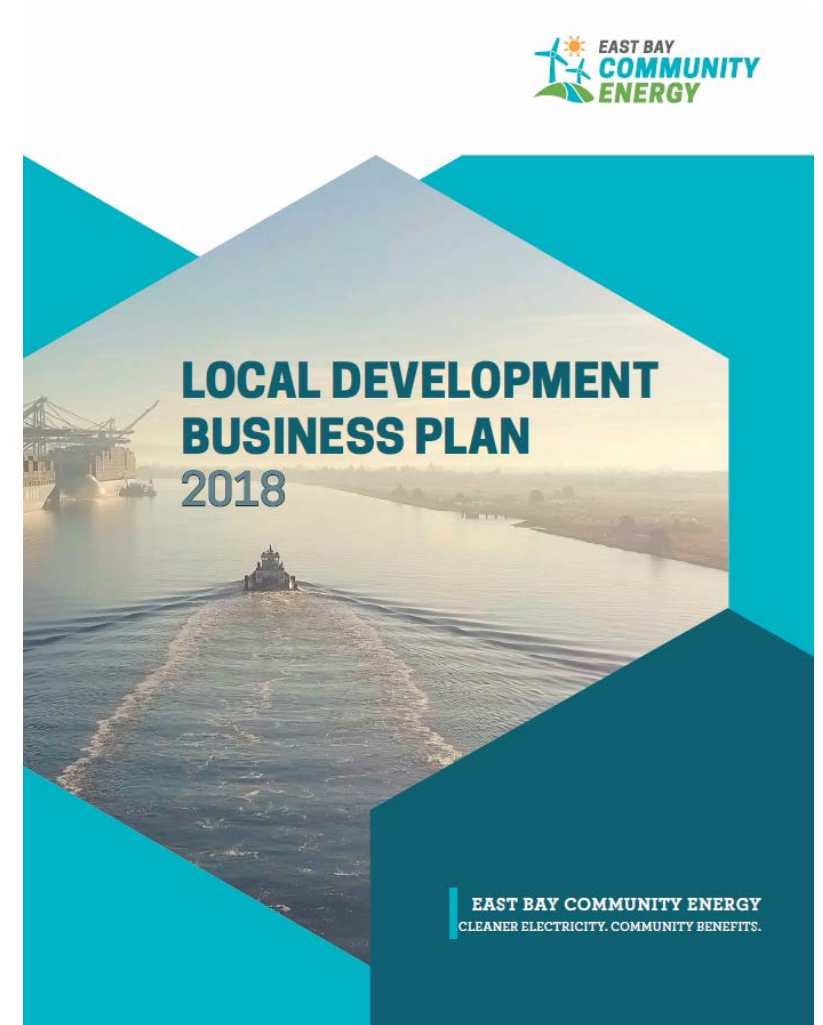

Local Development Business Plan

Early Actions for LDBP

1. Demand Response
2. Energy Efficiency
3. Building Electrification
4. Transportation Electrification
5. Collaborative Procurement (including municipal Feed-in Tariff and Community Shared Solar)
6. Enhanced Net Energy Metering
7. Community Investment Fund



LDBP – Priorities Identified by EBCE

Maintain Rate Discount – Bright Choice continues to be 1.5% cheaper than PG&E. Brilliant 100 continues to have rates equal to PG&E.

GHG Reductions – New local renewable energy facilities, energy efficiency, electrification of buildings and vehicles, etc.

Create Local Jobs – New local energy facilities or energy efficiency programs

Build Local Projects – Projects owned by member jurisdictions or larger scale privately-owned facilities.
