

Dear Groundwater Basin Stakeholders and Interested Parties,

This is an update on activities related to implementation of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) for the portion of the East Bay Plain Groundwater Subbasin that underlies the City of Hayward. On June 6, 2017, Hayward became the exclusive Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) for the portion of the Subbasin that underlies the City. The East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) is the exclusive GSA for the remainder of the basin, north of the City's boundaries. The City of Hayward and EBMUD plan to work together to develop a single Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) for the East Bay Plain Subbasin to sustainably manage and utilize groundwater. On November 6, 2017, the City of Hayward and EBMUD formally notified the State Department of Water Resources of our intent to work cooperatively to develop a GSP. A copy of the notification letter is attached.

Participation by stakeholders and interested parties is a key component of SGMA and sustainable groundwater management. We will continue to keep you apprised of our activities and provide opportunities to participate in development of the GSP.
