Key Findings of a Survey of Residents Conducted April 7-17, 2019



Methodology

- √ 663 interviews with registered voters in Hayward, weighted to reflect the adult population of the city per the US Census American Community Survey
- ✓ Conducted April 7-17, 2019, online and via landline and cell phones in English and Spanish
- ✓ Margin of sampling error of +/-4.0% at the 95% confidence interval
- ✓ Due to rounding, some percentages do not add up to 100%
- ✓ Selected comparisons to prior surveys conducted by Godbe Research








Views of the Hayward Community

Three-quarters of Hayward residents are satisfied with quality of life, though less intensely than they were a few years ago.


I'd like to get your overall opinion of living in the City of Hayward. Generally speaking, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the overall quality of life in Hayward?





Seniors are the most likely to say they are "very satisfied" with quality of life.


Hayward Satisfaction by Gender & Age





More than seven in ten are satisfied across ethnic groups, though intensity varies.


Hayward Satisfaction by Ethnicity

Hayward Satisfaction by Time in Hayward & Residence






Q1. I'd like to get your overall opinion of living in the City of Hayward. Generally speaking, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the overall quality of life

Most Important Change (Verbatim Responses)

A vibrant downtown and traffic control. They are building too many high-density housing units without planning for recreation and shopping.

Better education for kids. I think we have enough police. Let's focus more on schools and education.

Areas west of the 880 seem to be ignored.

There's a lot of traffic. It used to be a small town and now it's becoming a busy city.

Get rid of the Loop.

Just the street cleaning and making sure the environment is clean; it's just very dirty at times.

More action on road quality. There are too many potholes.

Rent control. It's so expensive I will have to leave the area soon.



Residents broadly describe the city as "diverse," "welcoming," and a good place to live and raise a family.



More than two in five are concerned about traffic on local freeways; homelessness and housing costs are also intense concerns.



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Very few, by contrast, are intensely worried about the rate of development.










Satisfaction with City Government


Three in five are satisfied with Hayward's resident services, similar to 2016.

Overall, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the job the City of Hayward is doing to provide resident services?






Seniors are the most satisfied of any age group overall.






African-American, and white residents are a bit more satisfied than Latino ones.





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Two-thirds of renters are satisfied, compared with a majority of homeowners.






Those who are dissatisfied with City services want to see traffic, police, homelessness and housing costs addressed.

Reasons for Dissatisfaction with City Services

I saw the new library they're trying build and I think it's a waste of money.

The resident services seem more targeted to wealthy areas than lowincome areas.

You have to commute to another town and work because the rent is too high.

The roads can't be driving more than 15 mph with knocking your teeth out. Also, the downtown area is very dangerous.

People are on the streets because it's too expensive to live.

I don't think we have enough police patrolling. There are a lot of packages stolen, mailboxes being broken into, and stealing of cars.

Bowling alleys, a skating rink, and theaters were closed years ago and weed-covered lots remain.

There are streets that are not lighted. It's scary to walk at night in those areas.

City of Hayward is not doing anything as far rising rents for middle class. Potholes are not fixed, garbage service is not great. Rising energy and gas prices are overlooked. Common people's voice not heard.

Most Important Improvement (Verbatim)

Rent control, improving schools, and traffic congestion.

Match the cost of living to wages. Both go hand in hand. People are leaving Hayward because rents have skyrocketed.

I would say increase in police training and how to handle gangs and relate to people. Improve access for those who don't use cars. There are too many sidewalks with mud/grass at the curb, interfering with wheelchair access at bus stops.

Traffic! The Hayward Loop was a horrible idea and with so much construction on new houses/condos traffic is only going to get worse!

A few years ago, repaving seemed to be a big project, but haven't seen much activity there recently. There needs to be a Pothole Elimination Team - make it a PET project.


Stop wasting money. They have a lot of programs.

Renegotiate the Waste Management contract. I'm paying \$70, while San Lorenzo is paying around \$26. Seems like someone is lining their pockets.

Provide more affordable housing for families and the homeless. I'm tired of seeing people sleeping in cars in my neighborhood.

A declining share feel they have the opportunity to voice their concerns about major community issues.


Overall, as a resident of the City of Hayward, how much of an opportunity do you feel that you have to voice your concerns on major community issues that affect your life?





Seniors and younger residents are more likely than others to say they had this chance.


Opportunity to Voice Concerns By Gender & Age





African-American residents are more likely than others to say they have an opportunity to voice their concerns.


Opportunity to Voice Concerns By Ethnicity





Assessing City Services


- Respondents were asked to rate the importance of 28 aspects of local life: is it extremely, very, somewhat or not too important to making Hayward a good place to live?
- Then they were asked whether they were satisfied or dissatisfied with the a list of 26 services and programs that largely corresponded with these aspects.
- We also looked at the interaction of importance and satisfaction levels to show areas of strength and areas for improvement.





Broadly, the most important aspect of life for residents is safety.





Affordable rent, disaster preparedness and job quality are also ranked highly.






Relatively less-important aspects have to do with public art and landscaping.





Satisfaction is highest for waste disposal, fire and emergency services, and downtown revitalization.







Nearly two in five are dissatisfied with neighborhood police patrols and street and sidewalk maintenance.




There has been a increase in satisfaction in the City's work retaining existing businesses.






Satisfaction with City Staff

In the past 12 months, did you contact a City of Hayward department for any reason other than an emergency?




Since 2008, surveys have found between 31% and 19% answering "yes" to this question.



For one-quarter of these residents, their contact is with the police.


With which City department did you have contact? (Open-Ended; Asked of Those with Contact Only, N=188)






Safety and Police Services

How safe do you feel in Hayward _____? Do you feel safe, unsafe, or neither safe nor unsafe?




Three in five are satisfied with courtesy and traffic safety maintenance of officers.

More than one-third are dissatisfied with neighborhood patrolling; fewer know enough to rate response time and crime fighting.





Q16. I am going to mention different aspects of <u>police</u> services specifically. I would like you to tell me how <u>satisfied</u> you are <u>personally</u> with the job being done by the City of Hayward Police in providing that program or service to City residents: very satisfied, somewhat satisfied, somewhat dissatisfied, or very dissatisfied.

Satisfaction declined on most metrics, largely due to increases in the share who do not know well enough to rate the police.






Funding for City Services

In your opinion, do you think there is a great need, some need, a little need, or no real need for additional funds to provide the level of City services that Hayward residents need and want?








A slim majority supports the idea of increasing taxes to fund a public safety center.



Support for Public Safety Facility Upgrade Proposal by Gender & Age






Majorities support the idea across ethnic groups, with differences in intensity.

Those who see a general need for funding are more likely to support the idea.


Support for Public Safety Facility Upgrade Proposal by Need For Funding




Residents say they were most likely to pay attention to their water bill or to someone they know when learning about the City.

They are much less likely to say they would pay attention to online platforms.






More than half said they are "extremely likely" to participate in the Census.

As you may know, every 10 years, the US Census attempts to count every American resident by asking them to fill out a Census questionnaire.


How likely are you to participate in the Census?








Younger residents are much less likely to say they will participate.






Lower-income residents are also less likely to say they will complete the Census.






Those with less than a high school education are less likely to complete the Census.

Conclusions

Conclusions

- ✓ While three-quarters are satisfied with Hayward's quality of life, the share who are "very satisfied" has declined relative to several years ago.
- ✓ Sources of dissatisfaction mirror trends in the broader Bay Area: concerns about rising cost of living (particularly housing), homelessness, and traffic congestion are broadly shared.
- ✓ Residents largely say they feel safe in the City, giving the police department good marks.
- ✓ They believe the city is diverse, welcoming and a good place to live and raise a family.
- ✓ Safety, efficient traffic movement, a clean city, disaster preparedness and affordable housing are among the most important aspects to quality of life.
- ✓ There is room for improvement on traffic and housing affordability.
- ✓ More than seven in ten say the City has a need for additional funding, though a
 general proposal to increase taxes for a public safety building had slim majority
 support. Further research should explore a ballot question and potential
 mechanisms.



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
