# Community Hub Services

## Health and Wellness Services

**Alameda County Deputy Sheriff's Activities League (DSAL)** provides information and enrollment assistance in free, after-school, recreational sports and summer fitness camps for kids; evening dance, boxing, and fitness programs for adults; and free, drop-in recreational soccer for families

**Eden Youth** is a youth-powered organization. Promotoras will host "grupo de apoyo" and share health and wellness resources in Hayward. The Substance Use Prevention team will provide awareness activities and educational programming.

**Hayward Evaluation and Response Teams (HEART), Case Management and Mental Health Linkages (LINK) TEAM** provides homeless outreach, information and resources, follow-up support, and assistance with navigating services. We can also connect to family counseling, crisis intervention, and more through the Youth and Family Services Bureau (YFSB).

**Horizon Treatment Services** is a youth-focused service. Staff will share resources on substance use prevention, mental health support, and programs for LGBTQIA+ youth, as well as provide information about upcoming events.

**La Familia** offers information and referrals to HPN community clinicians, Cal Fresh, and Medi-Cal as well as connection to prevention and early intervention services. Learn more about the youth workforce program for teens and young adults.



## Education and Early Childhood Development

**4Cs of Alameda County** will provide enrollment in parent workshops, toddler playgroups and family navigation to HPN community. Families can receive childcare referrals and information on payment assistance.

**Education Services** provides information and registration support in Hayward Library programs, such as ESL grammar classes, Citizenship workshops, Digital Literacy Classes. K-12 Homework centers, and more.

**Hayward Adult School (HAS)** provides information about class sessions and offer support to those interested in enrolling at the adult school.

## Senior Services

**Hayward Operated Paratransit (HOP)** will help seniors and people with disabilities to enroll in paratransit services.

**Center for Elders' Independence (CEI)** provides health care and services to help older adults live safely and independently in the community. We coordinate medical, social, and in-home services under one plan, tailored to each participant's needs.

## Legal Services

**Immigrant Hope** offers immigration law services, including family-based immigration, naturalization, work authorization, DACA, and renewals.
