

NOTICE OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMIT AND EXPENDITURE LIMIT FOR HAYWARD CITY ELECTED OFFICES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the current Voluntary Expenditure Limit per candidate established for the City of Hayward is adjusted by 2.45%, a percentage equal to the San Francisco Bay Area All Urban Consumers Price Index (CPI). The 2020 Voluntary Expenditure Limit is calculated to be **\$77,754**.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with <u>Hayward Municipal</u> <u>Code Section 2-13.04</u>, if a Candidate accepts the adjusted Voluntary Expenditure Limit, then he/she is entitled to accept the established contribution limit of \$1,000 per individual. Since 2006, this contribution amount has been adjusted and in 2019 increased to \$1,488 per individual. The contribution limit for 2020 per individual is **\$1,524**.

IN ADDITION, NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with <u>Hayward Municipal Code Section 2-13.03</u>, if a Candidate does not accept the adjusted Voluntary Expenditure Limit, then he/she is limited to the established contribution limit of \$250 per individual. Since 2006, this contribution amount has been adjusted and in 2019 increased to \$352 per individual. The contribution limit for 2020 per individual, if the voluntary expenditure limit is not accepted, is **\$359**.
