Community Hub Services

4Cs of Alameda County will provide enrollment in parent workshops, toddler playgroups and family navigation to HPN community. Families can receive childcare referrals and information on payment assistance. *Visit 4Cs on the 1st and 3rd Mondays from 11am–2pm.*

Chabot supports in applying and enrolling in non-credit ESL courses, Adult Career Technical Education, and Adult Dual Enrollment programs. Staff can assist with financial aid applications and provide information around the Chabot Promise program. *Visit Chabot on 1st and 3rd Mondays from 2pm–5pm.*

Hayward Evaluation and Response Teams (HEART), Case Management and Mental Health Linkages (LINK) TEAM provides referral, systems navigation, and short-term mental health services to promote safety and wellbeing. LINK connects to the Youth and Family Services Bureau (YFSB) family counseling, crisis intervention, and more. *Visit HEART on 1st and 3rd Tuesdays from 11am–2pm.*

La Familia offers information and referrals to HPN community clinicians, Cal Fresh, and Medi-Cal as well as connection to prevention and early intervention services. Learn more about the youth workforce program for teens and young adults. *Visit La Familia on 1st and 3rd Wednesdays from 11am–2pm.*

Alameda County Public Health Department (ACPHD) provides information about available programs and assistance with referral and enrollment to receive services. Nurses can provide blood pressure checks. *Visit ACPHD on 2nd and 4th Wednesdays from 11am–2pm.*

Fresh Foods for Families connects Hayward residents who have limited access to adequate amounts of nutritious food. *Visit Fresh Foods for Families on 1st and 3rd Thursdays from 11am–2pm.*

Alameda County Deputy Sheriff's Activities League (DSAL) provides information and enrollment assistance in free sports and activities for kids, adults, and families. *Visit DSAL on 1st Fridays from 11am–2pm.*

Tiburcio Vasquez Health Center (TVHC) provides information and outreach for all of the programs we offer on behalf of the clinic. *Visit TVHC on 1st and 3rd Fridays from 2pm–5pm.*

Hayward Adult School (HAS) provides information about class sessions and offer support to those interested in enrolling at the adult school. *Visit HAS on 3rd Fridays from 11am–2pm.*

Hayward Unified School District (HUSD) provides enrollment information for HUSD's Early Learning Program and Coordination of Services Team (COST). Families can receive support for their young children or if their family is experiencing a crisis. *Visit HUSD on 2nd and 4th Mondays from 11am–2pm.*

Horizon Treatment Services provides resources on substance use prevention, mental health support, and programs for LGBTQIA+ youth while also providing information about upcoming events. *Visit Horizon Youth Services on 1st and 3rd Tuesdays from 2pm–5pm.*

City of Hayward, Human Resources (COH HR) provides public sector interview prep and info about jobs and the hiring process. *Visit COH HR on 2nd and 4th Tuesdays from 11am–2pm.*

Hayward Operated Paratransit (HOP) will help seniors and people with disabilities to enroll in paratransit services. *Visit HOP on 2nd and 4th Tuesdays from 2pm–5pm.*

Eden Youth is a youth-powered organization. Our promotoras will host "grupo de apoyo" and share health and wellness resources in Hayward. Our Substance Use Prevention team will provide awareness activities and educational programming. *Visit Eden Youth on 1st and 3rd Wednesdays from 2pm–5pm.*

Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (HARD) provides information about scholarships and additional HARD programs and events. *Visit HARD on 2nd and 4th Wednesdays from 2pm–5pm.*

Hayward Promise Neighborhoods (HPN) will provide enrollment support in the Promise Entrepreneurship Initiative, share about CSU East Bay majors and campus life, connect patrons with Student Success Navigators, and link patrons to all HPN programs and partners. *Visit HPN on 2nd and 4th Thursdays from 2pm–5pm.*

Immigrant Hope offers immigration law services, including family-based immigration, naturalization, work authorization, DACA, and renewals. *Visit Immigrant Hope on 2nd and 4th Fridays from 11am–2pm.*

Education Services provides information and registration support in Hayward Library programs, such as ESL grammar classes, Citizenship workshops, Digital Literacy Classes. K-12 Homework centers, and more. *Visit Ed Services on 2nd and 4th Fridays from 2pm–5pm.*
