SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

RECOVERED HANDGUN: On 08/18/2024 at 12:10 AM, officers conducted a vehicle stop for an equipment violation near the intersection of A St and Garden Ave. Officers contacted the driver and saw suspected narcotics in plain view.
