- Get your name off marketing lists. 1-888-5OPTOUT (1-888-567-8688)- Removes your name from credit bureau marketing lists. (You will be asked to provide your social security #.....This is a secure phone line.)

- Write or apply on-line to have your name, address and phone number removed from many other marketing lists.
